Civilization & Society

The Xayari (The People)

The dominant species, the **Xayari**, are a curious, adaptable, and communal people.  Some Xayari have a natural connection with bio-organisms, allowing them to manipulate the growth of buildings, tools, and technology. They are seen as architects of society, shaping the world itself.

Conflict & Challenges

4. "Rooting" (Physical & Emotional Intimacy)

- Intimacy in Xayari culture is called "Rooting", a symbolic term for deep connection, physical closeness, and energy exchange.

2. Star-Gazing & "Sky-Walking" (Date Rituals)


- Since Xayari live underground, seeing the open sky is rare and considered a deeply romantic experience.

Anamatomy
