the only downside is that you'll have to learn some coding basics. they're

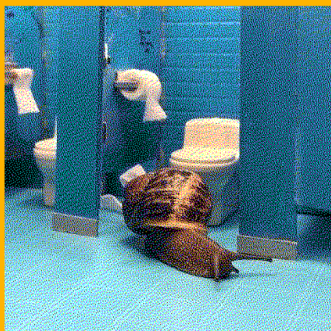
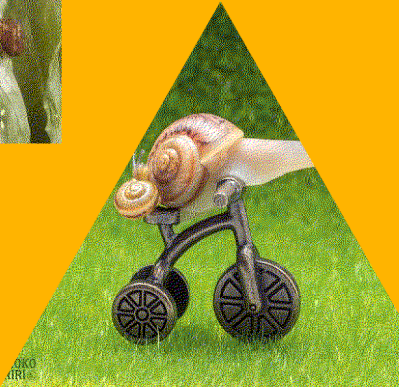
they're called basics for a reason though,,, coding is easy if you have google!!
