Islands of Insight

Famous and respected puzzle creator Elyot Grant has evidently been replaced by some sort of evil doppelganger, because he and a team of other puzzle makers have recently developed Islands of Insight—a puzzle game which many would say violates almost every principle of puzzle game design. The game has you exploring a series of floating islands littered with various types of what are referred to as puzzles, such as:

- Finding things in a glass maze.

- Finding things in a glass maze that are *invisible*.

- Looking at a series of stones from a certain perspective ti make a ring. This sounds interesting in theory, but it's always very obvious where you're supposed to stand, and the stones are absolutely everywhere. Player Abi referred to the stone puzzles as "litter".

- Finding cubes around the environment, which is very unfulfilling, as most of them will be found through going "Oh, hey, a cube" while doing something else, and the rest will be impossible to find among the dozens of ones you've found already.

- Flying through a series of rings, which isn't a puzzle, at all.

- Penpa puzzles, which are actually not bad, if you have the patience to get through everything else.

One could argue that the puzzles are easy in order to give players who aren't familiar with the genre an easier introduction, but it doesn't even do that. The main draw of a puzzle game, and the reason people enjoy playing them, is that the puzzles build on each other and evolve. Islands of Insight's puzzles don't do this; they're all more-or-less identical to the other puzzles of the same type. Sus1D1P called these puzzles

"busywork", and Raz said the game "gives a false impression of thinky games for new people".

In addition, the game has several attributes taken from other genres, for some reason. The game is an MMO, which means you get to see other players navigate the environment too, which is sort of interesting I guess, but the game also has a skill tree, which is just bizarre. The skills on the skill tree are all either ease of movement things, which should probably be unlocked by default, or things that solve a certain type of puzzle for you, which is not something a puzzle gamer would want.

So how did the game end up like this? Well, for one thing, Grant claims he wants to make a puzzle game with 10,000 puzzles in it. The only way to do this without making the game take 30 years to develop is to take a quantity over quality approach to design and fill the game with dodgy puzzles to increase the count, which seems to be what the developer did. And the bizarre non-puzzle elements? This is purely speculation, but it's possible the developer's only exposure to video games is AAA games, and many modern AAA games contain these same elements (seemingly out of a sense of obligation). This not only explains where the skill tree came from (he assumed games were supposed to have them, or that they needed them to be popular), but also why the game goes against puzzle design philosophies: the developer wasn't familiar with them.

Other players have equally low opinions of the game. Seren says that it's "a great game to recommend to your friend who buys a sudoku book, finishes the easy section, and buys a new sudoku book." Abi says it's "just not good puzzle or environment design". Placeholder says it's "at least bearable," so I guess it has that going for it. If you've already bought Islands of Insight, Witscord Weekly strongly recommends you delete it. If you haven't, we recommend you find a way to somehow delete it anyway.
