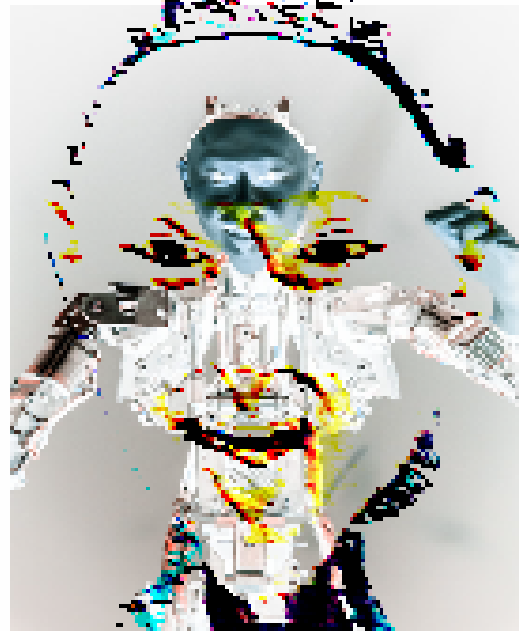
**Kerli Kõiv** (Estonian: [ˈkerli ˈkoiv] <sup>ⓘ</sup>) (born 7 February 1987), better known mononymously as **Kerli**, is an Estonian singer and songwriter.

Born in Elva, Kerli entered multiple singing competitions before being signed to Island Records in 2008 by LA Reid. In 2007, she released her debut self-titled extended play and in 2008, released her debut studio album, *Love Is Dead* which charted on the *Billboard* 200. The lead single from the album, "Walking on Air" charted in many countries and was also featured as the *iTunes Store*'s Single of the Week where it was downloaded over 500,000 times, a record at that time. In the years following, Kerli was featured on *Almost Alice* with the song "Tea Party" and she began to abandon her alternative rock sound and started to adopt a more electronic and dance-influenced sound, as can be heard in her 2010 single "Army of Love".

Following the release of *Love Is Dead*, Kerli began production on a second studio album which became her second extended play *Utopia*, released in early 2013, where it became Kerli's second release to chart on the *Billboard* 200.<sup>[2]</sup> Two promotional singles from the EP, "Army of Love" and "Zero Gravity", were released prior to the release of the album's first official single, "The Lucky Ones". All three songs entered the top ten of *Billboard*'s *Dance* *Club* Songs chart, two of them peaking at number one. Two songs which were co-written by Kerli for *Utopia* — "Skyscraper" and "Feel Immortal" — were later recorded by artists Demi Lovato and Lana Del Rey, respectively. Kerli's version of "Feel Immortal" was later released on *Frankenponic Unleashed!*.

In 2010, Kerli performed on *American Dancing with the Stars*; Vibe called the performance a "major milestone in the pop world."<sup>[3]</sup> In November 2013, Kerli left Island Records

# DOCTOR WHO

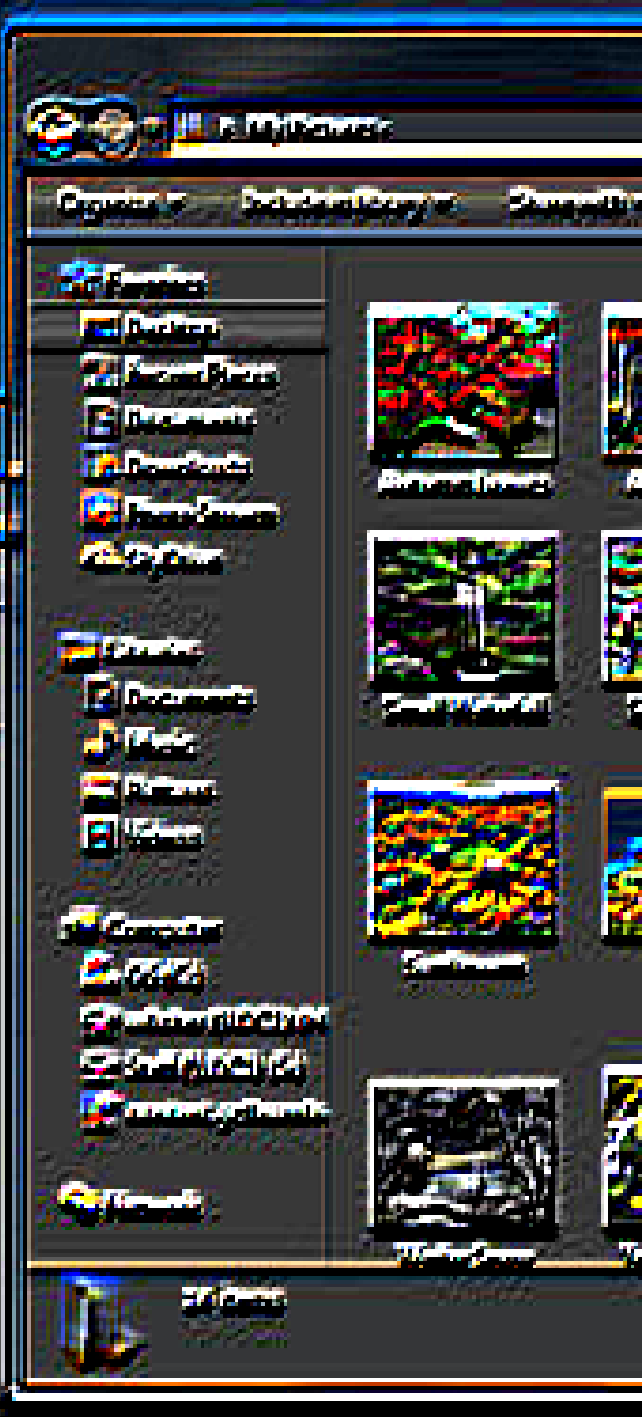
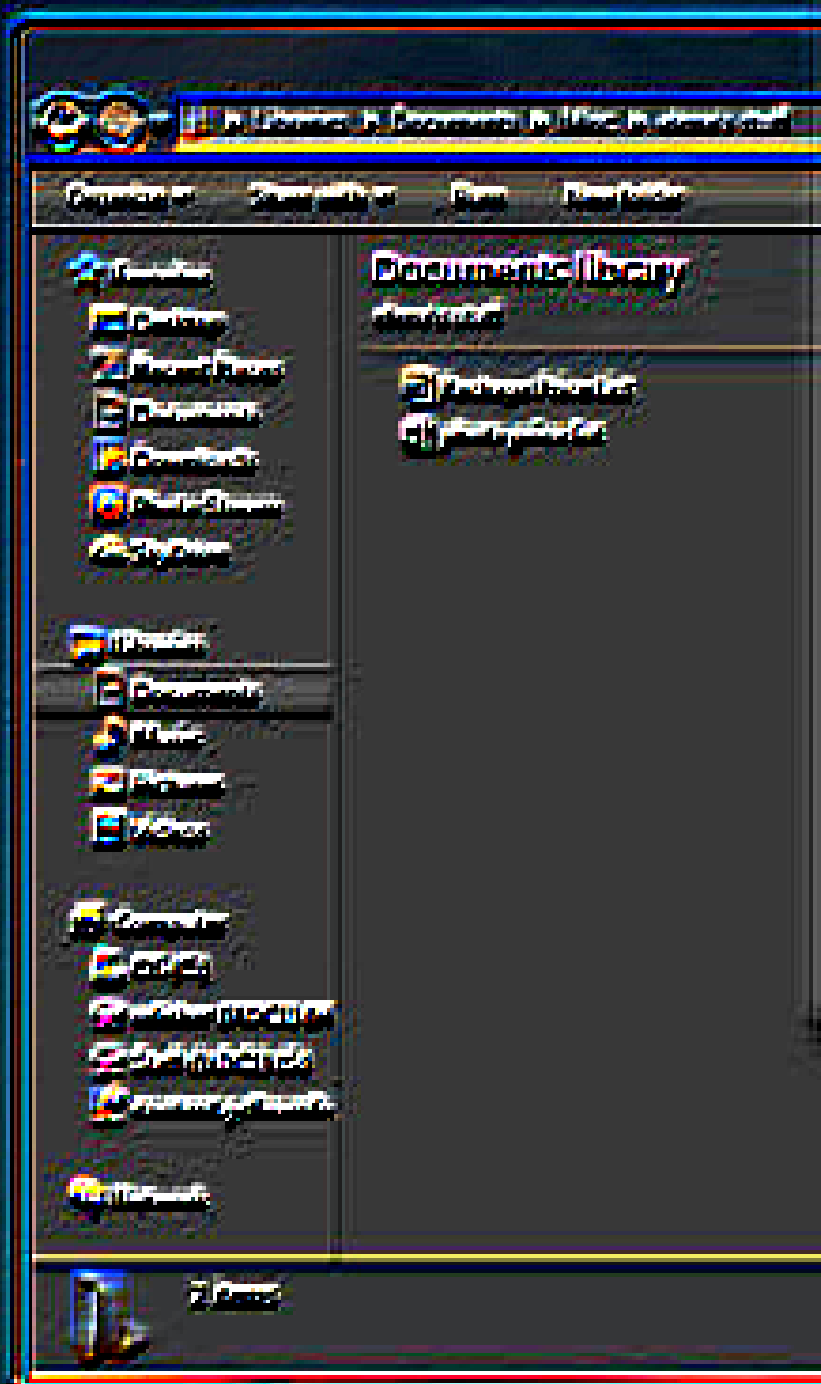

The Sims 3 is a 2009 social simulation video game developed by the Redwood Shores studio of Maxis, and published by Electronic Arts. Part of *The Sims* series, it is the sequel to *The Sims 2*. It was released on June 2, 2009, for Microsoft Windows, MacOS, and mobile versions. Console versions were released for PlayStation 3, Xbox 360, and Nintendo DS in October 2009, and a month later for Wii. The Windows Phone version was released on October 15, 2010. A Nintendo 3DS version, released on March 27, 2011, was one of the platform's launch titles.

The game follows the same premise as its predecessors *The Sims* and *The Sims 2* and is based around a life simulation where the player controls the actions and fates of its characters, the Sims, as well as their houses and neighborhoods. *The Sims 3* expands on previous games in having an open world system, where neighborhoods are completely open for the Sims to move around without any loading screens. A new design tool, the Create-a-Style tool, was also introduced. Create-a-Style allows for clothing, hair, as well as most objects and walls/floors to be visually customized, with several textures and materials available to use. Custom designs can also be saved for later use.
