RULE OF THIRDS

the basic guideline for composition in any

creating an interesting type of media

Theory states that if you place points of interest in the intersections or along the lines, it balances the image and allows natural interaction.



• To avoid awkward shots, off-center main subject to add additional points of interest.

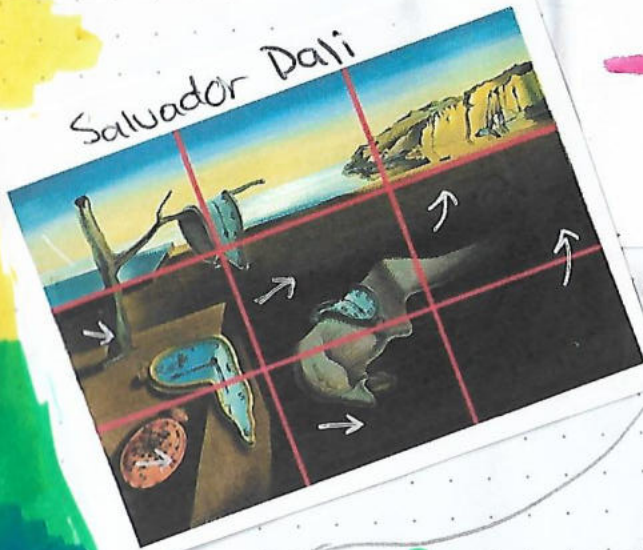
• You want to distribute the weight of the interests between the scale chart.

• Matching horizons to the horizontal lines can make very interesting shots.

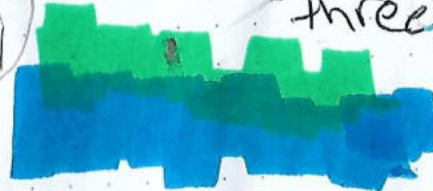

Composition should help carry the eye naturally to what has most weight in the piece



Place the **horizon line** somewhere above or below the midpoint. DO NOT place the horizon line in the middle.



MICHELANGELO MERISI DA CARAVAGGIO

1571-1610



- his name stems from his hometown in Lombardy
- had a horrible temper which led him to murdering a pimp and made him have to run for his life
- chaotic neutral face, hair
- Killed via fever
- used oils for painting

He never really propped when he'd prepare his art, he was a more of the moment type of person. He was also known for using random, ordinary people off the street to many of his fans' distaste.

I personally love his paintings + art style. It's extremely expressive while being realistic!! Amazing.

Caravaggio used two techniques known as the following:

TENEBRISM

tenebrae (darkness)
(Latin)

the use of extreme contrasts of light and dark in figurative compositions to heighten the dramatic effect

- Very dark background
- bright light source
- it's a controlled version of chiaroscuro

Chiaro (light)
Scuri Italian (dark)

CHIAROSCURO

First used by Leonardo da Vinci in late 15th century used to represent light and shadow to create 3D.

Tenebrism is the dramatic version of chiaroscuro.

born March 22nd 1929

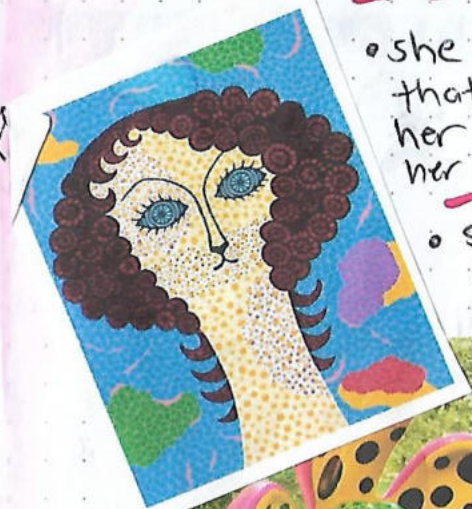
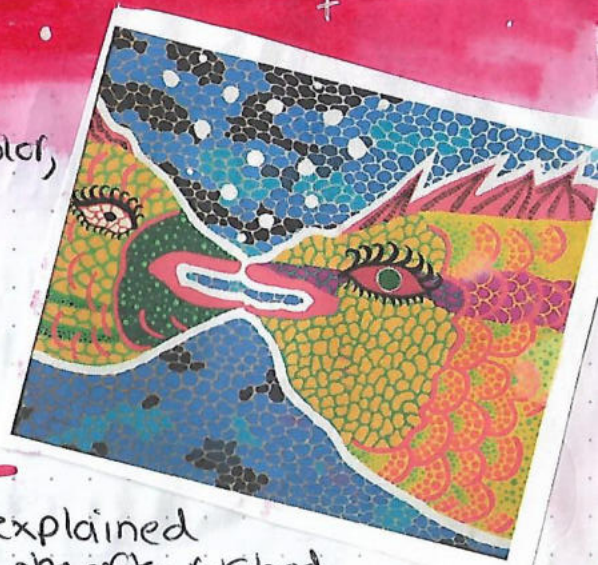
