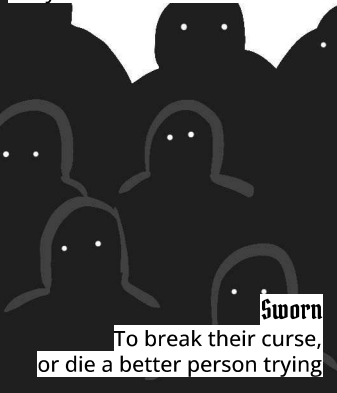


Micah Arecat

Of the silver phoenix

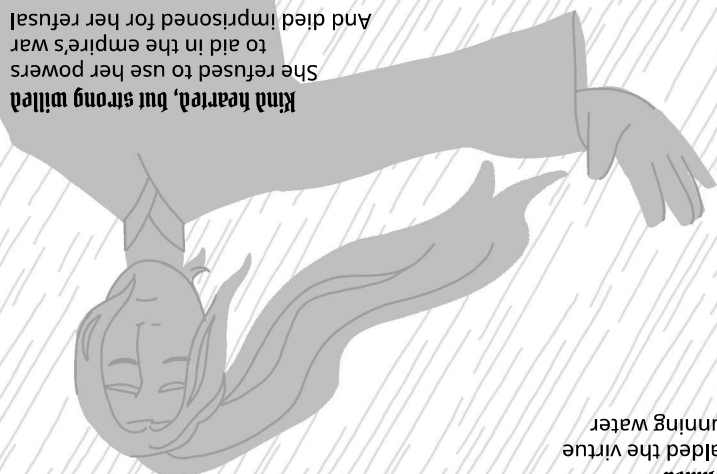


Haunted

drinkable in her presence

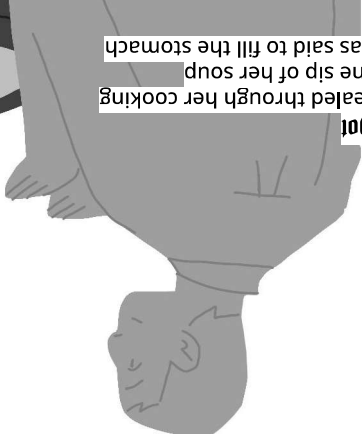


Purity

As famine barraged her home



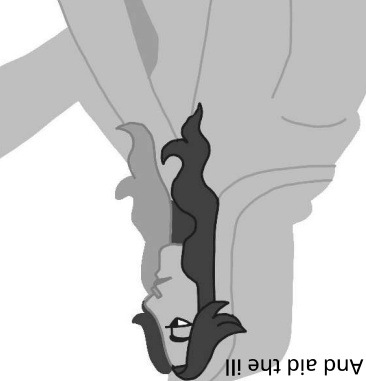
Agot

Shall haunt them in perpetuity

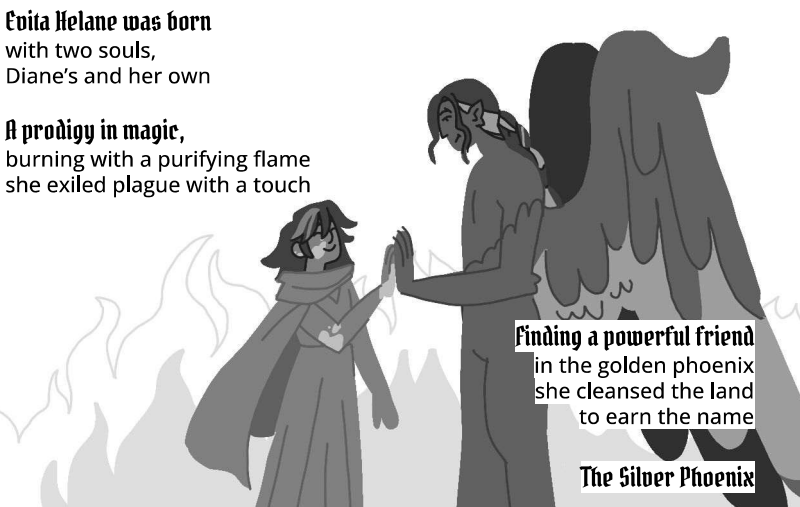


Kenata came next

she exiled plague with a touch



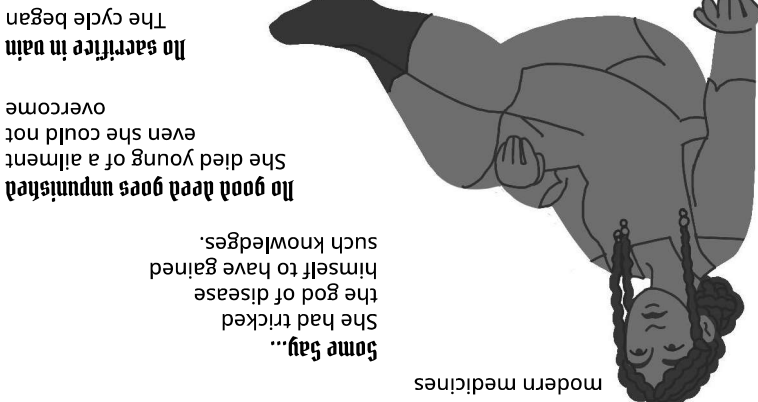
Finding a powerful friend
